## PLACEMENT RATE METHODOLOGY

New York State Bureau of Proprietary School Supervision requires placement rates be calculated for students who graduate between July 1 and June 30 of each year. (For example July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021.) For current rates click here to see Addendum B.

The National Accrediting Commission of Career Arts and Sciences requires placement rates be calculated for students scheduled to graduate between January 1 and December 31 of each year. For current rates <u>click here</u> to view the Annual Report Statistics.

Students are only included in the placement rate if they were employed prior to reporting deadlines. Only students who were employed in jobs within the Appearance Enhancement industry are considered employed in our placement rates.

Students may be excluded from our placement rates if they become permanently disabled, are deployed for military service, or are deceased.

## TYPES OF EMPLOYMENT

<u>Hairdressing and Cosmetology Program:</u> hairstylist, make-up artist, braider, natural hairstylist, colorist, designer, curly hair specialist.

<u>Esthetics:</u> skin care specialist, lash specialist, make-up artist, cosmetic sales, waxing specialist. With <u>Nail Specialty</u> added: nail technician, nail artist, pedicurist.

<u>Barbering:</u> scalp design, mustache and beard grooming (including eyebrow waxing), colorist, hairstylist, facial specialist.

Continental offers an active placement service to its graduates. Students receive assistance in developing resumes and are given fundamental job interview skills. Students may contact the school at any time after graduating to get further employment assistance. Continental School of Beauty cannot guarantee employment or salary level.
