

Completion/Graduation Rates Student Right-to-Know Act

In Accordance with the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, Continental School of Beauty Culture provides the following information on its completion rate of <u>first time</u>, <u>full time</u>, <u>certificate seeking</u> students that started school between September 1 and August 31 of every year. The regulation requires that institutions compile this information once 150% of the normal time to complete the longest program offered by the institution has elapsed.

During the period September 1, 2022, to August 31, 2023, <u>42</u> <u>full time</u>, <u>first time</u>, <u>certificate seeking</u> students began school at Continental School of Beauty Culture-West Seneca. After the expiration of 150% normal time to complete the longest program, <u>35</u> students or <u>83%</u> had completed the program. The following are the disaggregated rates for this cohort:
